## Summary

**Boredbrand's Digital Funfair** is a themed marquee full of interactive attractions which use computers, audio visual equipment and custom built physical interfaces.

The attractions run throughout the duration of the event much like an amusement arcade. The exception to this is the Virtual Coconut Shy which is compered and is timetabled.

The show usually appeals to people of all ages but depending on the event it tends toward a family crowd in the daytime and a party crowd at night.

## Space

Our marquee is a hexagonal bell tent which measures 9m point to point and stands 8m tall.

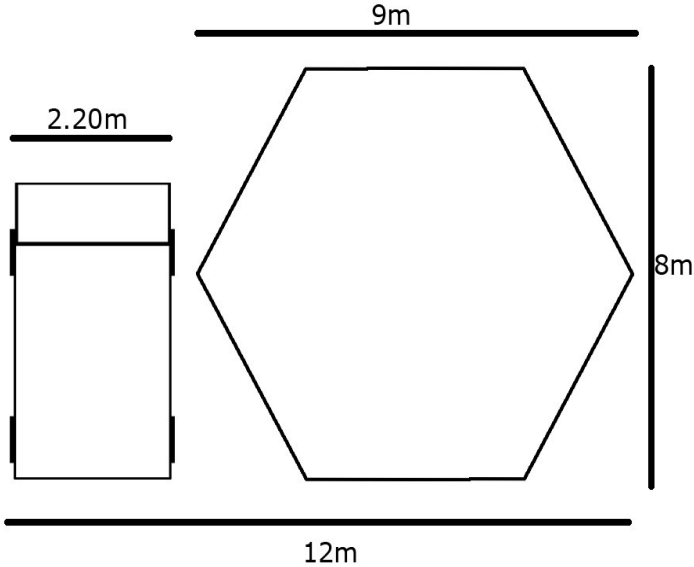
We also have a 7m x 7m frame tent which we tend to use for day events. It is approximately 3m tall.

For overnight events we require space for live in vehicles behind the tent.

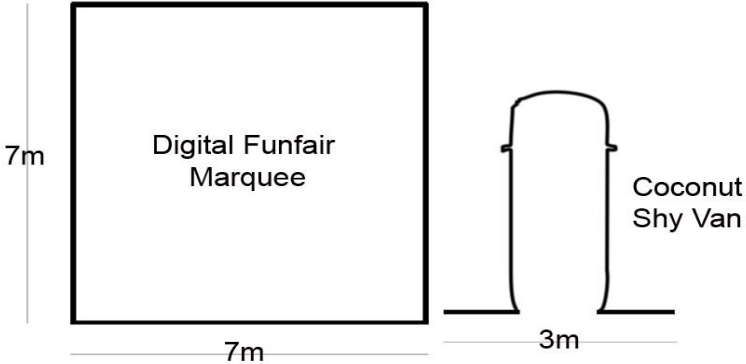
If available we use space in front of the tent for Table tennis, seating and if the weather permits, attractions.

The Virtual Coconut Shy can attract a large crowd around the back of the van, watching and waiting their turn.

# Set Up Times

The smaller set up we can have up and running in 3 – 4 hours. The take down is much quicker – around 1 hour.

With our larger marquee we need a day to set up. Again take down is quicker – around 3-4 hours.

# Power

At full power the funfair requires a maximum of 4.5KW of electricity. In practice it is much less.

If lighting is required two 16A supplies are ample, if not then one 16A feed is sufficient.

The power must generated be of a type suitable for usage with sensitive equipment ie pure sine wave. Standard events generators or grid power will be fine.

We require some power during the set up to test and calibrate all the attractions.

We ask for extreme caution with regards turning off the power before, during and after the event. We need a few minutes warning so as to power and shut down equipment.

# Sound & Light

Most of the pieces use localized sound eg computer speakers or headphones but the Beat Jigsaw and Coconut Shy are usually louder. We have 2 Alto PS4 HA active speakers which are rated at 400W each and can usually compete in loud environments.

Talk to us about how loud you would like us, if there are certain times when the volume needs to be lower eg late at night, if there is a nearby show which needs quiet etc

Our sign is lit with a string of 40W coloured bulbs. These will probably be replaced with led equivalents as the old type become less available in the shops. Inside the tent we use LED Par Cans and Rope Lights.

## ***Vehicles***

We carry the bulk of the equipment in a Mercedes Sprinter Box Van 6.5 m long and 3.5m tall.

For overnight events we have an older Mercedes lorry 6.5 x 3.7m and/or a Mercedes 508 6.5m x 2.7m.



## ***Overnight Security***

Requirements vary from event to event and we need to discuss these in advance. We usually sleep behind the marquee and lock valuables in vehicles overnight. We may require harris fencing for the backstage area and in urban environments, hired in security.
